



Forsythe II Project: Unit 39, 42, 75 & 76

cluster of large
DF
of LP 12" thinned
pocket on shelf

large 5" LP near edge of old growth (11-12")
14", multiple tag trees
also limber pine young

Blue spruce cluster
more likely following
along stream, huge pondo
on opposite side of stream

perennial stream
animal track continues up hill on animal track, lots of deadfall

Top of drainage been following. Forest a little denser, still thin trees and close on west, more widely spaced east.

forest looks thinned already; smaller trees spaced well apart

heavy ground fuel (old).
old growth (11-12")
Evidence of moose (scat).
Bolted Tree (trail Maintained)
Dead fall
Animal/Social Trail running west to east

Naturally thinned/open LP.
Joins major wildlife trail.
Elk scat.
Several 10-12" LP

pink ribbons?, LP and fir, 1"-5", 2'-15' apart.

End of lodgepole for slope, moved into open pondo for mix conifer

very dense deadfall self thinning

heavy ground fuel
Limber pine & spruce & df

Aspen & snags
Limber pines
Ground juniper & snags & ground fuel.

rocky knoll, view point spectacular

with DF regen. Could in regen. Some spruce and ground juniper. Aspen patches.
