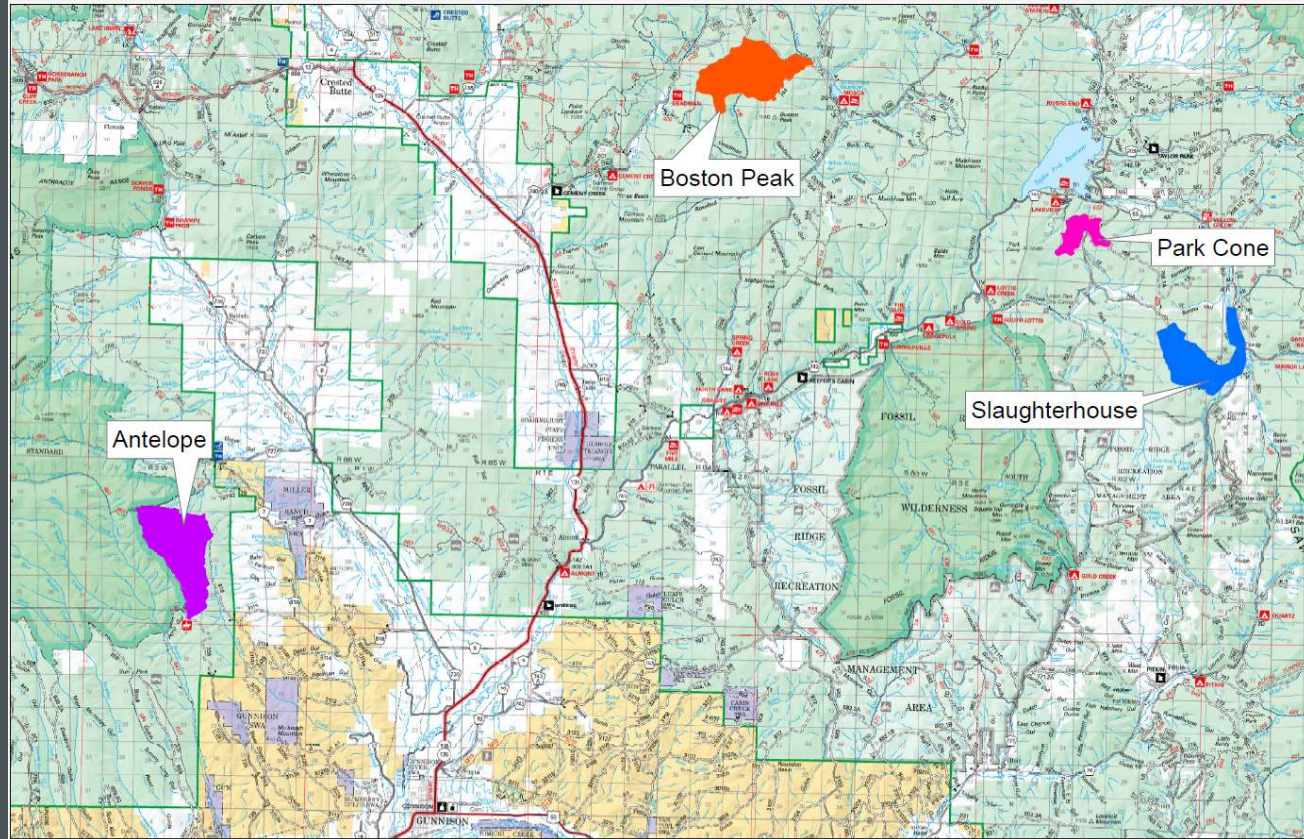

 - Small timber sales to local industry

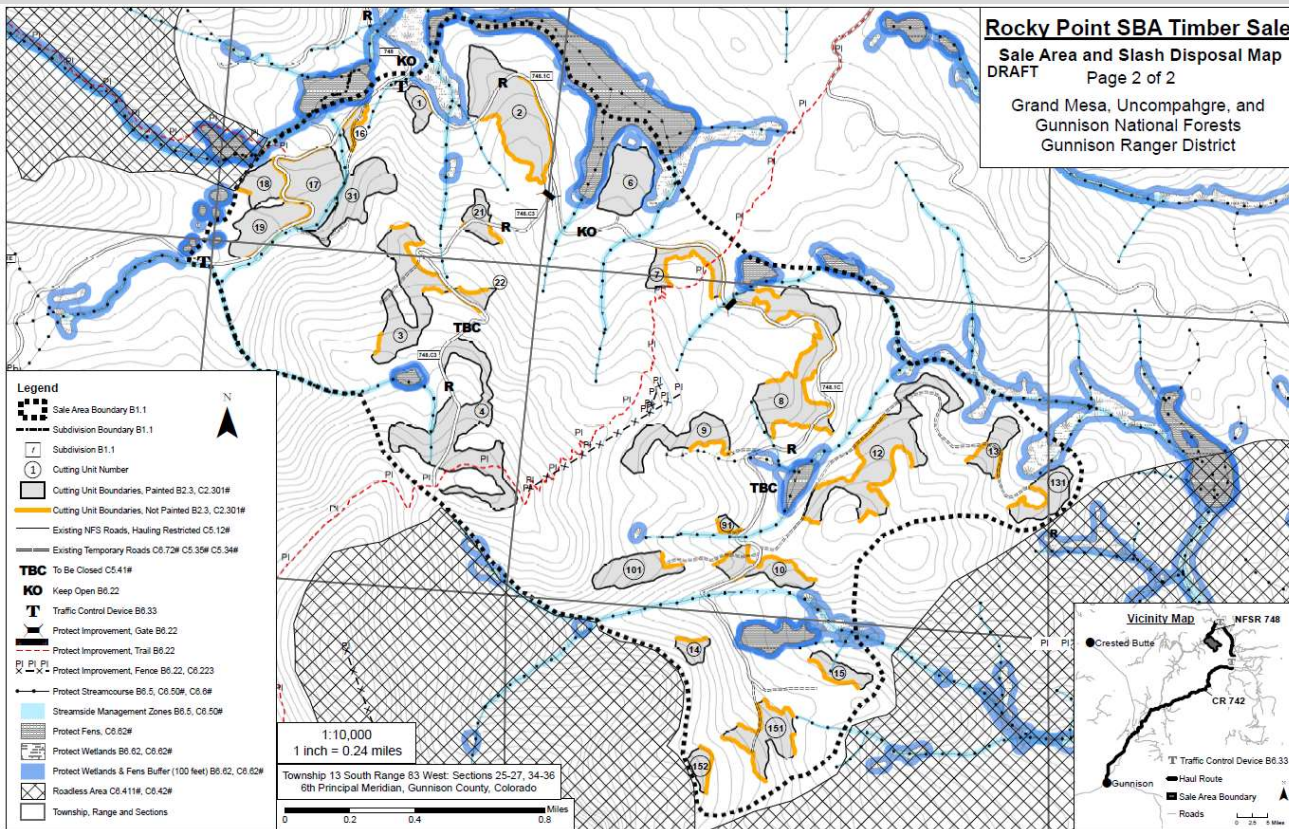


- **Orange** – currently under contract

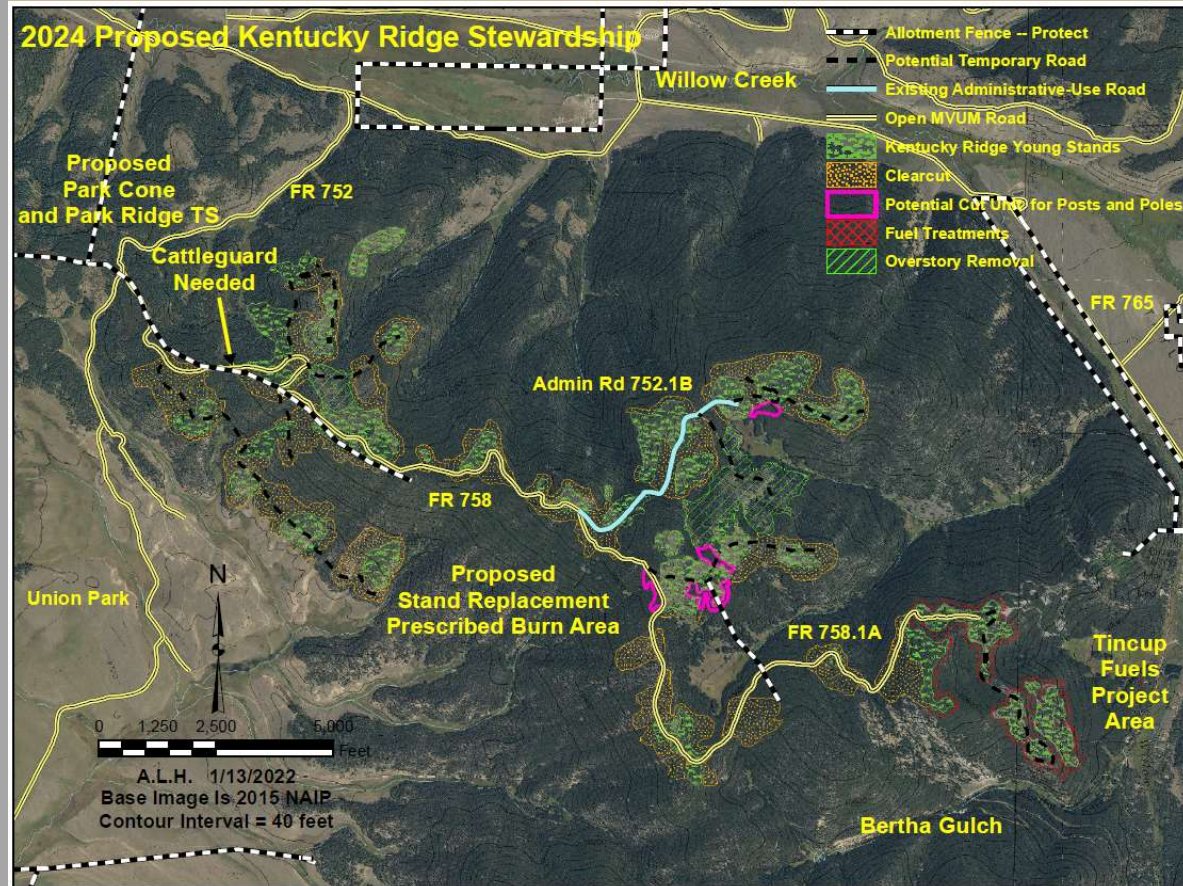

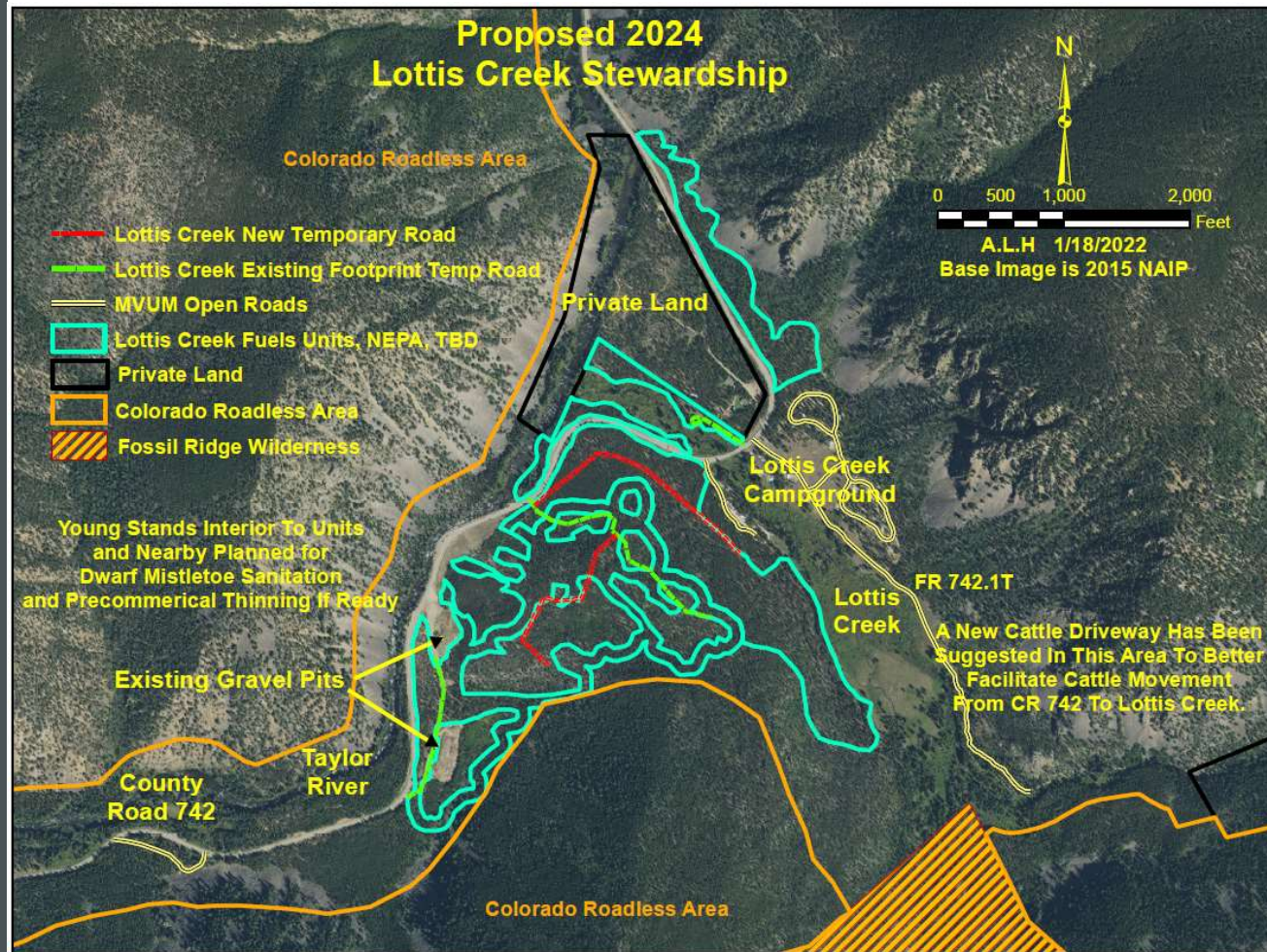

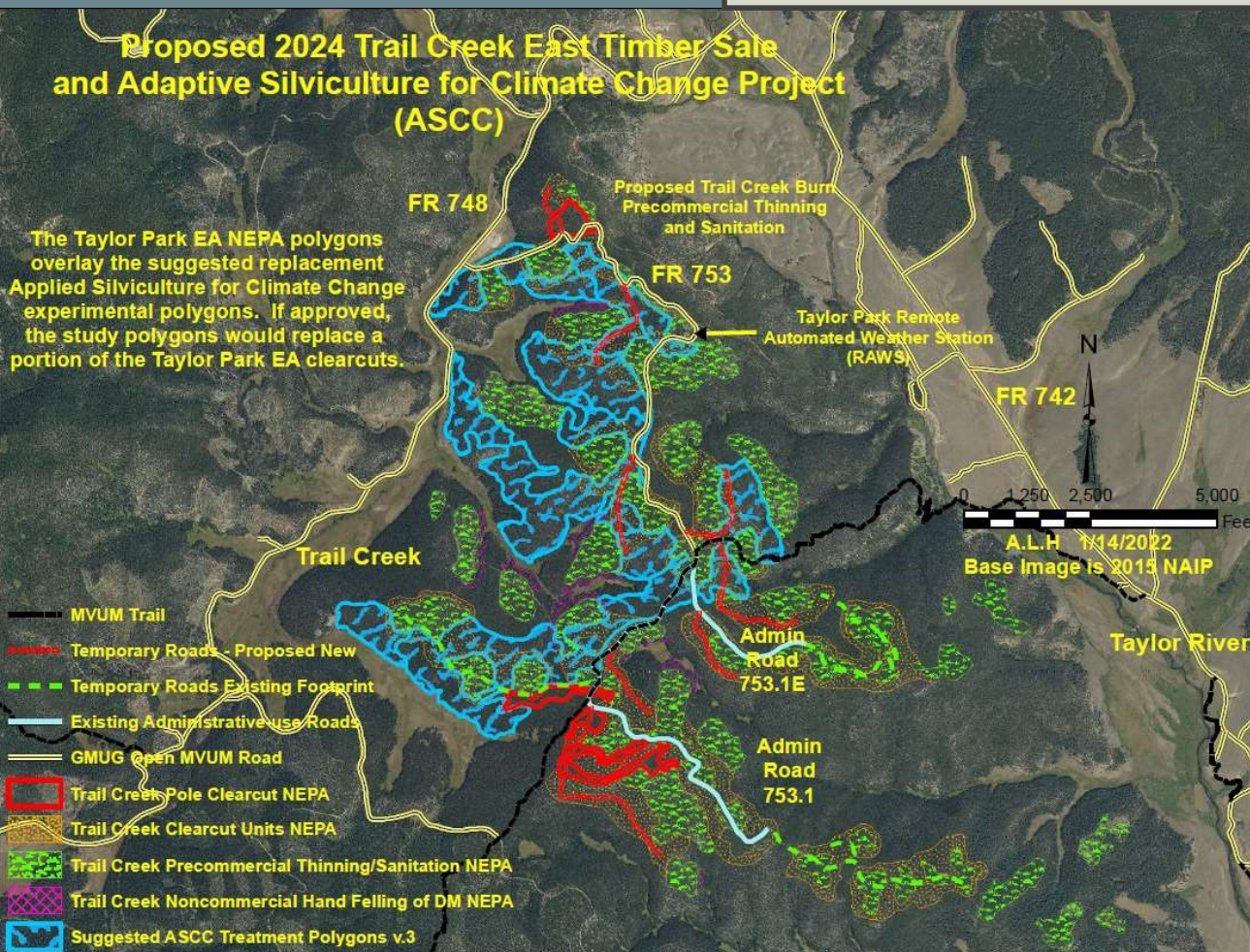

 - Decking of products not removed

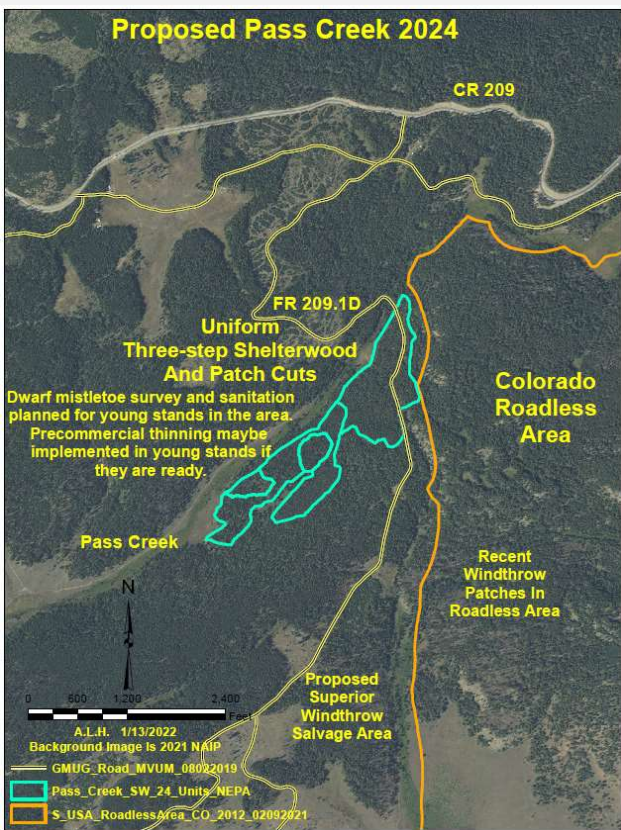


TRAIL CREEK EAST - ASCC

- Treatments include:
 - Clearcut
 - Commercial & precommercial thinning
 - Fuel reduction clearcuts & pruning
 - Experimental prescriptions

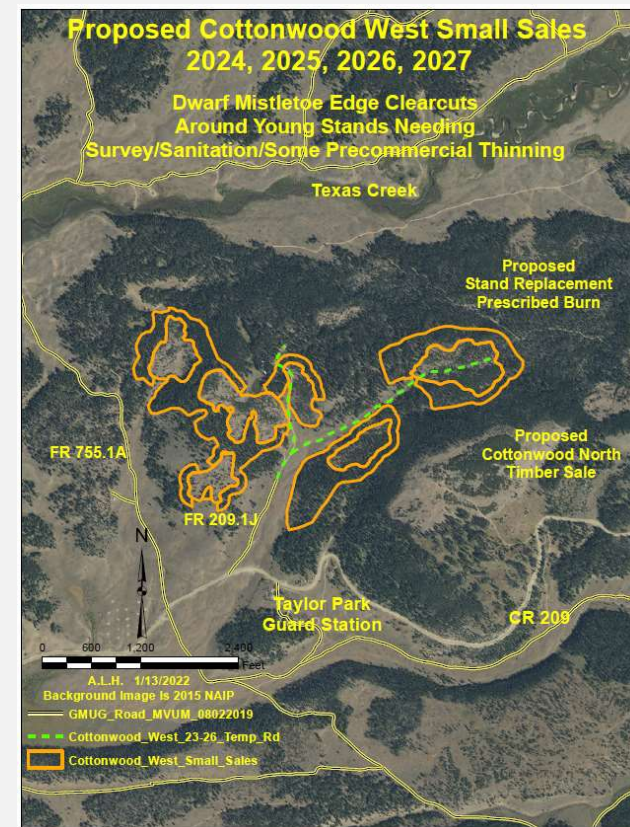

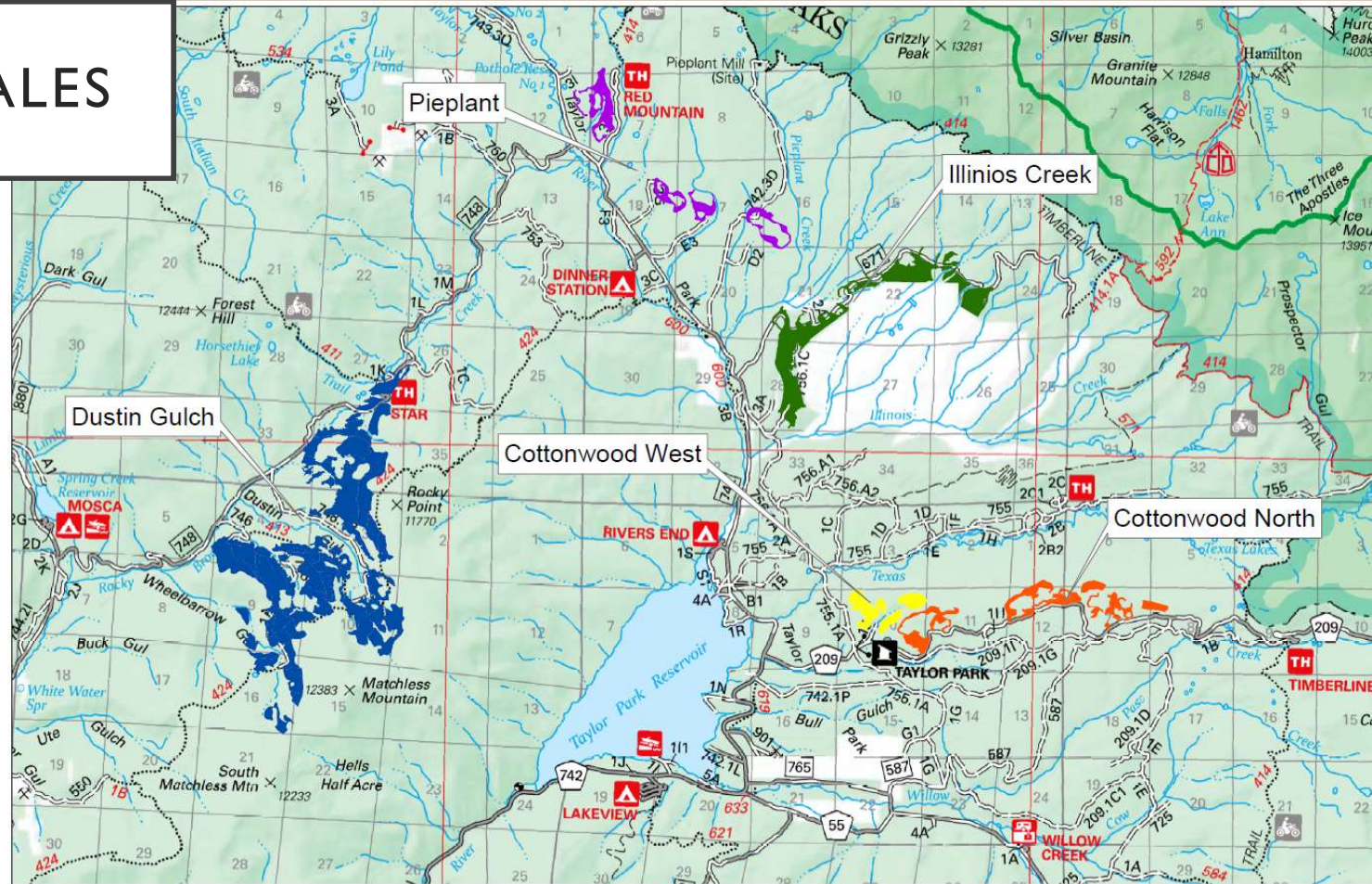

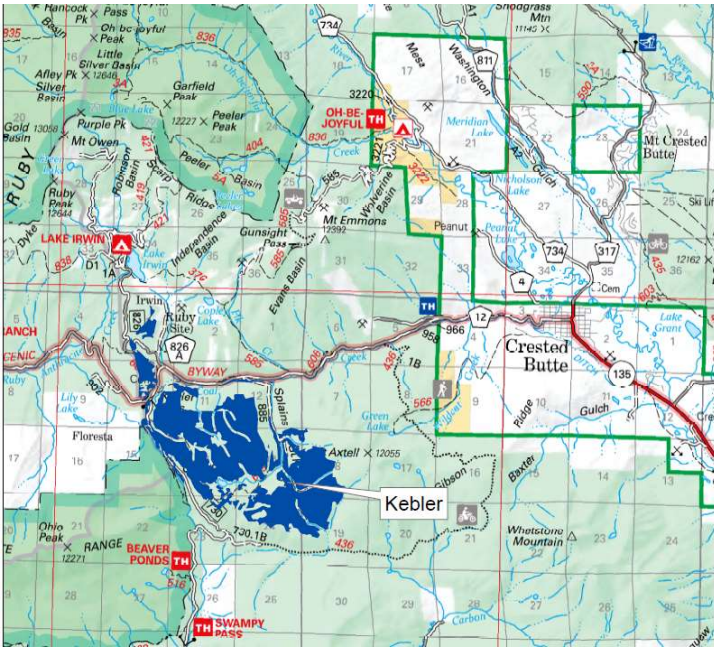

SBEADMR REFORESTATION

- 2021 – Planted 219,300 seedlings forest-wide mostly on SBEADMR units
- 2022 - Planted 178,440 seedlings forest-wide mostly on SBEADMR units
- 2023 - Plan to plant 154,305 more seedlings, also mostly on SBEADMR units
