



#### SLAUGHTERHOUSE TIMBER SALE



- ~3.9 miles of temporary road construction & reconstruction
- Treatments include: edge clearcuts
- Late fall and winter operating season
  - September 10<sup>th</sup> February 28th
  - Termination date March 30th, 2029
- Updates
  - Addition of Specified Road Package
  - Addition of Tincup units
- Currently advertised
  - Bid opening April 27th, 2023

- Treatments include:
  - Edge clearcuts
  - ICOY prescription
  - Commercial & precommercial thinning
  - Decking of products not removed
- Implementation through combination of:
  - Slaughterhouse Timber Sale
  - NFF & CSFS Partnerships
  - Small timber sales to local industry



- Orange currently under contract
  164 acres, 1300+CCF
- Blue to be sold, operations FY23/24
  - 177 acres
- Red planned future treatments
  - 718 acres



  - Termination date September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2027
- Planned advertisement spring 2023





  - Decking of products not removed




# TRAIL CREEK EAST - ASCC

  - Commercial & precommercial thinning
  - Fuel reduction clearcuts & pruning
  - Experimental prescriptions





- 2021 Planted 219,300 seedlings forest-wide mostly on SBEADMR units
- 2022 Planted 178,440 seedlings forest-wide mostly on SBEADMR units
- 2023 Plan to plant 154,305 more seedlings, also mostly on SBEADMR units
